DESCRIPTION The South-West Oltenia Regional Development Agency (SW Oltenia RDA) is a non-profit organization, non-governmental, non-political, of public utility, with legal personality, which acts in the field of regional development. Also, we are part of Ro-Boost SMEs Consortium that was established in 2014 and that since 2015 has become a partner of Enterprise Europe Network. The aim of the Consortium is to develop a support structure for SMEs in the two regions, West and South-West Oltenia, through which will provide an integrated set of information, support services and consultancy to help SMEs to use European business development opportunities.
